Cascadia is a very sweet Snap Pea developed by Dr. James Bagett and Oregon State University. The 3.5" (8.9 cm) deep-green, thick and juicy pods are filled with flavor. Cascadia has the honor of being the first Enation-Mosaic resistant variety ever introduced.
