Parsley Pea a new variety from Pure Line Seeds that is used for the pea shoot, clipping and specialty markets.

The leaves are clipped at a young stage when they have a sweet pea flavor. They can be added in salads or other recipes. Harvest the pea plant when it is roughly 2-3 inches tall by cutting the whole plant and adding it to salads, a side dish, or simply to snack on!

The tendrils are clipped at a young stage when they are still tender and have a sweet pea flavor. Parsley Pea also produces pods and can be eaten like a normal shelling pea. The peas contain some of the sweetest and greatest pea flavor within our portfolio.
