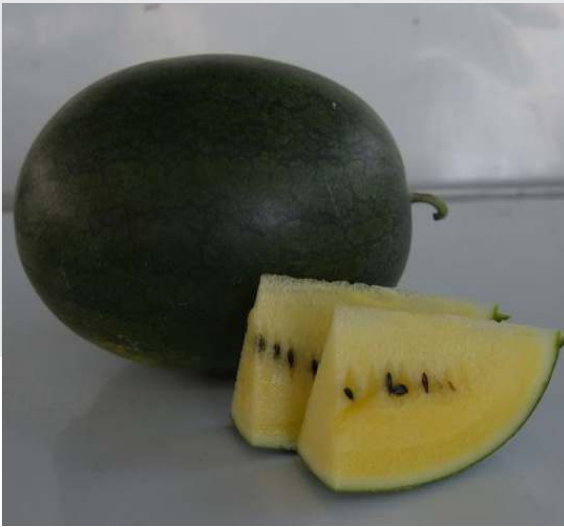


YELLOW BUNTING F1

diploid watermelon



About:

Yellow Bunting F1 is an early-matured yellow-flesh-type variety. Strong setting ability that can carry 3 fruits per plant, weighted 6.0 lbs average and can reach up to 11 lbs. Harvest at about 55 days after transplant, and can have second setting if plants are taken care of. Rind is as thin as 0.6cm but firm enough for storage and transportation. The flesh is charming yellow in color, delivering a soft, smooth, fiber-less, and very sweet taste with the high brix, 11.5-12.5%.
