El Camino is a high yielding pickling cucumber that produces a uniform, dark green fruit. It is a monoecious variety developed for growing in the open field as well as greenhouse spaces. The fruit holds well after harvest and is excellent for canning. A key benefit to El Camino is its outstanding multi-virus resistance, including CMV, PRSV, WMV, and ZYMV.
