

SUNNYSIDE F1

sunflower, helianthus



SunnySide F1 offers pollen-free flowers with overlapping orange petals and a dark center. This radiant variety is less sensitive to day-length changes and continues to perform well under short-day conditions. By sowing outdoors from early spring to mid-summer and with a cultivation time of 8-11 weeks, you can harvest this variety from early summer to late autumn. The strong stems and large, sturdy buds hold up well during transport and processing. As the flowers of SunnySide F1 are pollen-free, the flower hearts and petals remain clean, resulting in longer shelf life.
